MUSIC FOR YOUNG TEACHERS PROGRAMS

If you are looking for piano or music lessons in the Etobicoke area, but want a fun and enriched fun way for your child to learn, MYC is the perfect program for you!

MYC is a child-focused music program which uses a multi-sensory approach to learning. We sing songs, we play the keyboard, play rhythm instruments, compose music, participate in listening activities, and complete homework assignments, all while having FUN!

Please have a look at all the great programs offered at The Busy Genie (lower level) for ages 3 to 10! We may also be opening up the MUSIC PUPS (ages 0-4, 45 minute classes) in the near future. Sunrise Program – ages 3 to 4

In the *Sunrise* program you can expect your toddler to learn the music words “beat” and “rhythm”, how to recognize and read tonal as well a rhythm patterns. Early learning concepts including counting to 10, right/left, fast/slow, loud/quiet are explored and reinforced through musical activities. Class activities include: singing, dancing, finger plays, simple games, crafts, stories, listening activities, rhythm instrument play along and ensembles. The program offers children exposure to a wide variety of music styles and flavours. *Sunrise* is a parent participation program and is taught in 1-hour/week, three (3) 10-week blocks. Fee is equivalent to \$20 per student per hour. Materials and Manuals are extra. Maximum 3 per class.

Sunshine – Age 4



Sunshine is a keyboard based program for 4 year olds. The program runs from September through May (35 weeks) with weekly one hour classes. The children are taught in small groups, each having a participating partner (parent) to support them through the class. Sunshine students learn through a cast of “critter” friends that make musical concepts come to life in an age-appropriate way. The activities, songs, puppets, games and stories hold the attention of this age group and reinforce

concepts that would otherwise seem complicated. Students in the Sunshine program will learn all the notes on the keyboard as well as notes on the staff: Treble Clef C, D, E & Bass Clef C & B. They also will be able to identify patterns, play in ensembles, learn basic theory & be able to identify rhythms through ear and sight. Fee is equivalent to \$20 per student per hour. Materials and Manuals are extra. Maximum 3 per class.

Sunbeam – Ages 5 & 6



Sunbeams are students that are 5 and 6 years old and learning keyboard for the first time. They learn much similar to the Sunshine program, with keyboard critters and our fun rhythm critters, but at this age they progress much faster through the material. By the end of the year they are playing their scales hands together and have learned how to harmonize through bridges (the beginning of chords). Fee is \$774.00 per year or \$77.40 per month for 10 months. The materials cost for Sunbeams 1 this year is \$162.64. This includes 3 music/workbooks for the year, a student activity book, a parent guide, a “tin sheet” and magnets for learning notes, a castanet, and a stylish carrying case. The materials fee is non-refundable, as it is ordered per student from the MYC head office. Maximum 4 per class.

Moonbeam – Ages 7 to 9

For the older beginner, ages seven through nine, the program lasts three years. Our Moonbeams want “quick results” and the songs, ensembles and keyboard repertoire are designed to support their growing sense of independence. The listening activities for this age group keep the “ears open” even as reading becomes the primary focus for gathering information. Fee is \$774.00 per year or \$77.40 per month for 10 months. Materials fee is \$163.60.

Students at the final level, Moonbeams Three, are thoroughly prepared for Grade One Conservatory examinations and have, in many cases, been awarded the Conservatory Silver Medal, the highest mark provincially, for Grade One Piano.

Even more important, the MYC graduates (and parents) are very highly motivated for further study in music and private teachers have found many of the students so well prepared for private lessons that they have accelerated them through Conservatory Grades Two and Three in one year! Maximum 4 per class.
